# Exploring What I Believe: An Overview of Christian Theology

Thursdays at 7:00 pm beginning January 26, with instructor Melody Merida. Ten weeks. Hosted by the Love Looks Like Oasis.

Do you know why you believe what you believe? This course walks through some of the great questions people have about faith, God, and Christianity: How was the Cosmos created? Who is Jesus? Do we have free will? What should I believe about heaven and hell? What should I believe about the second coming?

Tough questions will be asked. Open discussion will be encouraged. We won't pull any punches. When we're finished, you'll know a whole lot more about *what* you believe and *why*.

## Spiritual Principles for Dating

Thursdays at 7:00 pm beginning January 26, with instructors Jeff Miner and David Zier. Eight weeks.

Do you sometimes experience frustration with the challenges of being single, especially when it comes to dating and seeking a spouse?

Successful relationships begin before they are formed; they begin with a solid foundation to guide dating and the early months of a new relationship. Topics covered include key mistakes, strategies for choosing the right spouse, hormones and judgment, how soon to have sex, and when to move in together.

## Discipleship 101

Mondays at 7:00 pm beginning January 23, with instructor Keith Phillips. Ten weeks.

Are you ready to take your spiritual life to a new level? In Discipleship 101, you will **engage the words of Jesus Christ directly for yourself,** in all their power and mystery. Instead of relying on someone else to tell you what these words mean, you will form your own conclusions, with the benefit of open discussion. We will focus on two major questions:

- What does it really mean to be a follower of Jesus?
- How can I deepen my personal relationship with God?

This course will challenge you to take a fresh look at what Jesus said and evaluate where you stand.

You will be encouraged to make concrete decisions about next steps, *at your own pace*, when it feels right. You will be offered options for putting what you learn into practice, so that the rhythms of your life increasingly reflect the faith of your heart.

After receiving the elements, please return to your seat by the side aisle. If you would like to receive Communion but are unable to come forward, please notify an usher.
