Are you ready to take your spiritual life to a new level? In Discipleship 101, you will **engage the words of Jesus Christ directly for yourself,** in all their power and mystery. Instead of relying on someone else to tell you what these words mean, you will form your own conclusions, with the benefit of open discussion. We will focus on two major questions:

Upcoming Election: Board of Directors

We have three Board of Directors positions open for election at our February 12 Congregational Meeting. Consistent with our bylaws, we have formed a Nominating Committee to recommend candidates for the open positions. A notice was also placed in the *Weekly News* in November inviting individuals interested in being nominated to step forward.

Two of the three Board members whose positions are up for election, Todd Cox and Sheryl Holko, are willing to continue serving and the Committee is pleased to renominate them. A third Board member, Tony Benner, has served for almost 12 years. He's now ready for a rest, and we celebrate and honor Tony's service!

At the congregational meeting, the Directors will propose that we increase the size of the Board from 9 to 10, with two positions for finance — Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer. For these positions, we are nominating Jon Hamilton and Donna Hays. Jon is a long-time member of our church who runs an accounting company. Donna is a long-time member who has served as the Missions Board Treasurer.

Big Impact at GCN Conference

Two weeks ago, Pastor Jeff and David Squire, our Communications Director, attended the *Gay Christian Network Conference* in Orlando. These GCN Conferences tend to draw many young adults who are newly out and in the process of reconciling their faith with their orientation. About 500 attended the conference.

Jeff presented two workshops based on *The Children Are Free*. The workshops focused on Matthew 8, where Jesus encounters a gay Roman centurion, and Mark 7, where Jesus rejects creation order theology. These workshops were among the most highly attended at the conference.

Jeff also hosted a workshop entitled *Are You Called to Ministry?* The goal was to offer our LifeJourney Pastoral Training Program as an option. Twelve individuals attended that workshop, after which five people scheduled one-on-one conversations with Jeff. We anticipate several of these individuals will visit our church within the next year to evaluate whether to prepare for a life of professional pastoral ministry at LifeJourney Church.

Meanwhile, David Squire (and his partner Dave Wene) staffed a booth at the Resource Center, offering resources published by LifeJourney Press — not just *The Children Are Free*, but also a CD set on principles for relationships, our devotional *Quench!*, and our *Discipleship 101/102* materials. We set a record for sales.

As you can see, many were blessed deeply by the presence of LifeJourney Church at the GCN Conference. Your generosity made that possible! Thank you!
