Friendship and Belonging Really Matter

Church ought to be a place for friendship and belonging. God designed us that way. Even in the very beginning, God said, "It is not good for the human to be alone." As the old *Cheers* song says, "Sometimes you want to go where everybody knows your name, and they're always glad you came." In ancient Christian literature, it's called "the beloved community" — followers of Jesus getting to know each other at a deep level and building close-knit community.

Growing our capacity to support deep friendship connections is the number-one goal for LifeJourney Church for 2012. And the best way to do that — the best way to grow our friendship connections — is through regular small-group gatherings where we get to know each other, learn more about spiritual life, and walk life's path together. **Oasis** is what we call this at LifeJourney Church.

If Someone Asks You for Money

Occasionally on a Sunday, someone will wander into our church and start randomly asking people for money or favors, like a ride. If you ever have that experience, **take that person to one of our Deacons or Church Staff**, so we can assess the situation and deal with it in an appropriate and sensitive way. Unfortunately, sometimes scam artists may take advantage of your kindness. By referring requests to a Deacon or Staff member, we can assess legitimacy.
