### A Sanctuary Etiquette Tip

It's not uncommon for people to need to leave the sanctuary during worship service — and that's just fine. But when you return, please keep a few simple guidelines in mind.

Certain parts of the worship service are more easily disrupted than others. **If you return during a prayer, the sermon, or special music, please don't walk all the way back to your seat.** This will cause many to be distracted at key moments of worship. Instead, please take a seat near the back of the sanctuary. Then return to your regular seat at the next moment of general circulation, such as the offering or a congregational song. Thanks!
