Holy Week at LifeJourney Church

Maundy Thursday, April 5, 7:00 pm

Good Friday, April 6, 7:00 pm

LifeJourney Press Job Posting

The publishing ministry of our church - LifeJourney Press - has grown substantially. Our initial book on homosexuality and the Bible, *The Children Are Free*, has become one of the best-selling titles in its subject area, is being translated into several languages, and is having a global impact. Meanwhile, as needs are identified, we have begun to gradually expand our products to include discipleship materials for churches, a daily devotional for individuals, and a sermon series on relationships. Historically, LifeJourney Press has been staffed entirely by volunteers. But now we're ready to experiment with a part-time Marketing Coordinator position.
