Explore Membership: October 30 and November 6

Membership Class will be offered **next Sunday and November 6,** from 1:00 to 3:00 pm. Both sessions are required. Lunch will be served at each session beginning at 12:30 pm.

At LifeJourney Church, we view membership as a *sacred commitment* that should not be entered into lightly. Membership is for those who have taken time to get well acquainted with the church, feel excited about what we're doing together, and are ready to make a deep commitment to our common work and to caring for their souls.

To become familiar with LifeJourney Church before making a membership decision, we encourage (but do not require) you to first take *Discipleship 101* and *102* — two Soul*Shift* classes that explore our relationship with God and church. These courses will be offered in January.

When you become a member, we ask you to commit to a **Soul Care Plan** — an *intentional, self-crafted plan for spiritual development.* An overview of the Soul Care Plan is given in membership class, and it's covered in depth in Discipleship 101/102.
