# What if I don't want to use electronic giving?

You're also welcome to place checks or cash in the offering on Sundays. Some who give this way use offering envelopes, which are optional. You can pick up a box of envelopes at the table by the info kiosk.



## Why is regular giving so important?

- You get the blessing of knowing that you're changing lives through the work of this church.
- Generosity is a basic spiritual virtue; practicing generosity grows our souls.
- Regular givers have the most impact. Someone who gives a small amount on a predictable schedule has far more impact than someone who gives even larger amounts at unpredictable intervals. Regular giving allows the church to plan ministry endeavors with confidence, knowing the money will be there.
- Jesus said, "Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap. For the measure you give will be the measure you get back." Luke 6:38.
- Donations are tax deductible; tax receipts are distributed at year end.
